

## SOLDERING SMALL JOBS

A small disposable cup is a handy holding tool for small soldering jobs where you need that extra hand.

Half fill the cup with water to steady it and help keep it cool. For a good solder joint you should heat the job with the soldering iron until it (the job) is hot enough to melt the solder ... simply melting the solder onto a cold joint doesn't make a good connection.

Cut slits into the sides of the cup to help hold wires or other small materials in position while you solder them. The cup also catches the drippings from the soldering.
