

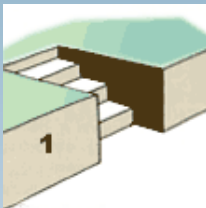

STEPS, AN EASY WAY TO CHANGE LEVELS

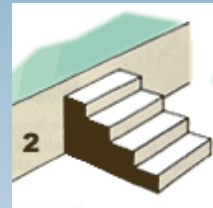
Steps are an easy way to change levels in your garden. They take up a minimum of space and they don't have to be boring.

You can use a variety of materials to construct steps, including concrete, stone, bricks and timber or you can use a combination of any.

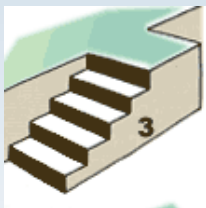
The accompanying diagrams show some possibilities when steps are used in conjunction with a retaining wall.



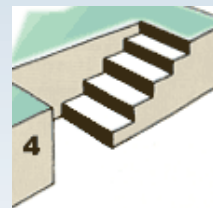
1. Contained within the wall



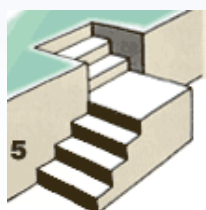
2. Project out from the wall



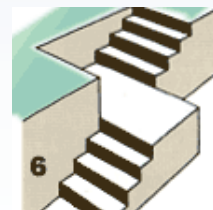
3. Parallel alongside the wall



4. Parallel within the wall



5. Partly contained and partly alongside with a single landing



6. Partly parallel contained and partly alongside with double landing
